Consists of two main components: Lexile measure & Lexile scale

The Lexile measure is the numeric representation of a reader's ability or a text's difficulty.

The Lexile Framework for Reading is a scientifically proven approach to reading and text measurement.

The Lexile scale is a developmental scale for reading.

Reading Ranges: 190L for beginning readers to above 1700L for advanced text.

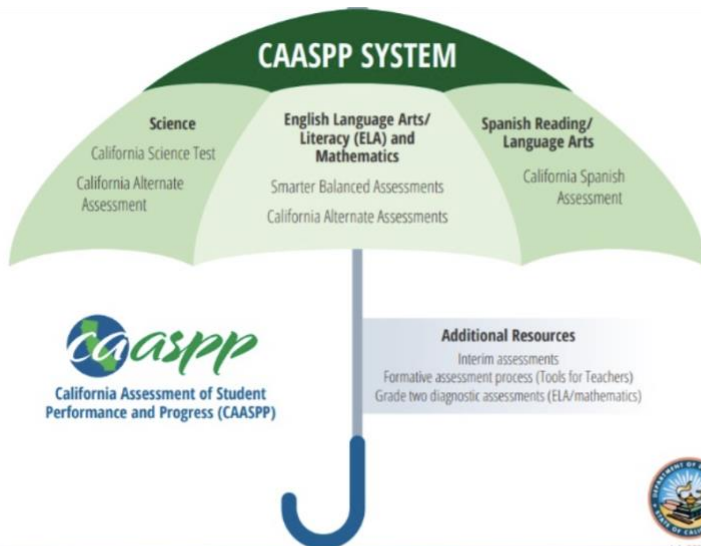

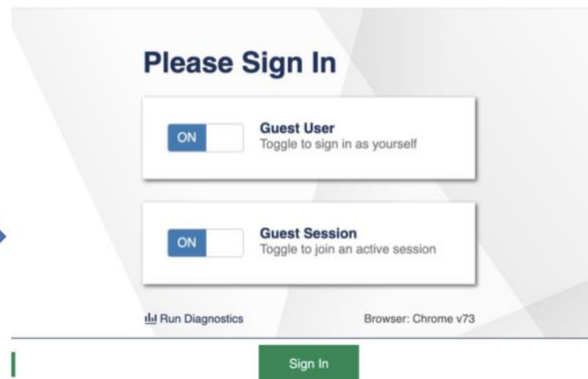
What Can I Do To Help My Child?

- Take the Smarter Balanced Practice Test Together
- Ensure they Get Plenty of Rest and Eat a Great Breakfast
- Read Together
- Reading, Language Arts:
 - Talk to your child
 - Ask complex questions
 - Have your child explain their thinking
 - Have your child practice writing stories, their opinions
- Mathematics:
 - Ensure that your child can:
 - Subtract, Add, Multiply, Divide (according to their grade level)
 - Talk to your child about how you use Math in daily situations
